AN ORDINANCE RENAMING THE ASIAN DEVELOPMENT BANK SPOUSES ASSOCIATION (ADBSA) AYTA INTEGRATED SCHOOL, LOCATED IN SITIO BANAG, BARANGAY PALANGINAN, MUNICIPALITY OF IBA, ZAMBALES, TO 'BANAG AYTA INTEGRATED SCHOOL' AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, Section 1, Article XIV, of the 1987 Philippine Constitution mandates that the State shall protect and promote the right of all citizens to quality education and shall take appropriate steps to make such education accessible to all;

WHEREAS, Section 13(c)(3) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991," authorizes the Sangguniang Bayan, in consultation with the Philippine Historical Commission, to change the name of municipal public elementary, secondary, vocational or technical schools, and other public educational institutions within its jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, Section 13(e) and Section 99(d) of the same Code empower the Local School Board to recommend the change of name of public schools for enactment through an ordinance by the Sangguniang Bayan;

WHEREAS, Department of Education (DepEd) Order No. 29, s. 2011 ("Revised Guidelines on the Naming and Renaming of Schools") and DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2014 ("Revised Guidelines on the Establishment, Merging, Conversion, and Naming/Renaming of Public Schools, and Separation of School Annexes in Basic Education") provide that the name of a public school must carry historical and cultural significance and contribute positively to community development;

WHEREAS, the school administration of ADBSA Ayta Integrated School, together with stakeholders including parents, teachers, Ayta leaders, and community members, formally requested the renaming of said school to "Banag Ayta Integrated School" to reflect the heritage and identity of the Ayta community it serves;

WHEREAS, on August 22, 2025, the Local School Board of the Municipality of Iba recommended to the Sangguniang Bayan the enactment of an ordinance renaming the school, thereby honoring the Ayta community's cultural heritage and fostering a stronger sense of pride and belonging among learners and residents;

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Bayan of Iba, Zambales, in session assembled, that:

SECTION 1. OFFICIAL SCHOOL NAME. – The Asian Development Bank Spouses Association (ADBSA) Ayta Integrated School, located in Sitio Banag, Barangay Palanginan, Municipality of Iba, Province of Zambales, is hereby officially renamed as:

"BANAG AYTA INTEGRATED SCHOOL."

SECTION 2. RATIONALE – This renaming recognizes the cultural heritage, identity, and aspirations of the Ayta community in Sitio Banag, ensuring that the school's name reflects the community it serves.

SECTION 3. COORDINATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (DepEd) – The Sangguniang Bayan shall transmit this Ordinance to the Schools Division Superintendent of Zambales for its reference and appropriate action. Moreover, a copy of this Ordinance shall be forwarded to the National Historical Commission of the Philippines for its information and reference.

SECTION 4. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE – If any part or provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other parts or provisions not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 5. REPEALING CLAUSE – All ordinances, resolutions, executive orders, and other issuances, or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.
