AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE “MUNICIPAL YOUTH ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION PROGRAM” IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF IBA, ZAMBALES

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) is mandated under RA 10742, otherwise known as the Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Act of 2015, to implement programs, projects, and activities that promote the welfare, development, and empowerment of the youth;

WHEREAS, environmental protection is a shared responsibility of all citizens, including the youth, to ensure a sustainable and healthy community;

WHEREAS, involving the youth in tree planting, clean-up drives, and awareness campaigns, fosters environmental stewardship, civic responsibility, and active participation at the municipal level;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Iba, Zambales in session duly assembled;

SECTION 1. Title - This ordinance shall be known as the "Municipal Youth Environmental Protection Program Ordinance of Iba, Zambales".

SECTION 2. Coverage - This program shall cover all youth aged fifteen (15) to thirty (30) years old residing in the Municipality of Iba, Zambales.

SECTION 3. Objectives - The program aims to:

- (a) Promote environmental awareness and responsibility among the youth.
- (b) Encourage active participation of the youth in municipal-wide clean-up and tree planting activities.
- (c) Contribute to a greener, cleaner, and healthier municipality.

SECTION 4. Program Components - The SK Federation, in coordination with respective barangay SKs, shall coordinate and conduct:

- (a) Municipal Clean-Up Drives – Youth volunteers from all barangays shall participate in clean-up activities in public places, riverbanks, and streets.
- (b) Every Second and Third Quarter, Municipal Tree Planting Initiatives – Planting trees in designated municipal parks and deforested areas.
- (c) Environmental Youth Summit/Camp – This shall be conducted every June of the year. These include seminars, workshops, and campaigns on waste management, recycling, and tree care in all barangays.

SECTION 5. Funding - An annual budget of Php (amount to be determined) shall be allocated from the SK Federation Fund to support materials, tools, seedlings, transportation, information campaigns, and other logistical needs. Additional funding support may be solicited from government agencies, NGOs, and private sector partners, subject to existing laws and regulations.

SECTION 6. Coordination and Reporting - The SK Federation shall coordinate with:

- (a) Barangay SK Councils – for mobilization and participation of youth volunteers.
- (b) Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office (MENRO) – for technical assistance and site identification.
- (c) Municipal Youth Development Office and the Sangguniang Bayan – for the submission of quarterly reports, and for program monitoring and evaluation.

SECTION 7. Separability Clause - If, for any reason, any provision or part of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions shall remain valid and in full force and effect.

SECTION 8. Repealing Clause - All ordinances, resolutions, rules, or regulations, or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended, or modified accordingly.

SECTION 9. Effectivity - This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.

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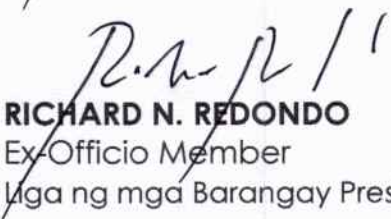

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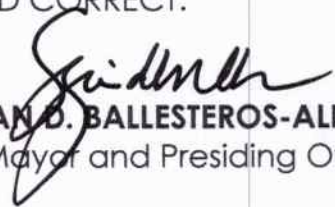
