AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE IBA LEGISLATIVE AWARDS FOR BARANGAYS (ILAB), PROVIDING GUIDELINES, CRITERIA, INCENTIVES AND FUNDS THEREFOR

WHEREAS, there is a need to institutionalize a performance-based recognition system that promotes legislative excellence, transparency, accountability and innovation among Barangays;

WHEREAS, the Barangays as the basic political unit, serves as the primary planning and implementing unit of government policies, plans and programs, projects, and activities in the community, and activities in the community, and as a forum wherein the collective views of the people may be expressed, crystalized, and considered;

WHEREAS, to carry out its mandate, a Barangays has its own Sanggunian, to enact ordinances and resolutions for efficient and effective provisions of the basic services and facilities enumerated in Section 17(b) of the 1991 Local Government Code;

WHEREAS, conferring an award to Sanggunian Barangays, that excel in the enactment of ordinances and adoption of resolutions, will surely motivate members of the Sangguniang Barangays to demonstrate their utmost efficiency in the legislative process for the general welfare of their inhabitants;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SB Raedag Villamin Jr. the Sangguniang Bayan of Iba, Zambales in session assembled;

Be it Resolved to enact this Ordinance.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Iba, Zambales;

SECTION 1. TITLE - This Ordinance shall be known as the Iba Legislative Awards for Barangays (ILAB) Ordinance No. 13-29, Series of 2026.

SECTION 2. PURPOSE - This award accords recognition to Sangguniang Barangays that excel in the enactment of ordinances or resolution that ultimately contribute to the attainment of desirable socio-economic and environmental outcomes, in the Barangays. Specifically, ILAB aims to:

1. Bestow official recognition to innovations and recognition and distinctive practices in Barangays Legislation;
2. Institutionalize a system of recognition to the Sangguniang Barangays for Exemplary performance;
3. Inspire Barangays Legislators to excel in the performance of their functions;
4. Encourage the passage of responsive, lawful and sustainable local legislation.

SECTION 3. GENERAL GUIDELINES; AWARD CRITERIA

3.1.1. Availability of Legislative Documents (25%) - the completeness, organization, and accessibility of legislative records, including approved ordinances, resolutions, minutes of sessions, meetings, committee reports, attendance records and other official documents.

3.1.2. Effectiveness of Performances of the Sangguniang Barangays (40%) - the impact of enacted ordinances on Barangays governance, economic growth, public service delivery, and environmental sustainability. The quality, enforceability, and measurable impact of ordinances shall prevail over the mere quantity of enacted measures.

A. Ordinance and Resolution shall be aligned with the Executive Agenda of the Municipal Government, which shall include, but not limited to the following:

- A1. Human Capital development
- A2. Economic transformation
- A3. Infrastructure development
- A4. Climate Disaster Resilience
- A5. Good Governance and Social Protection
- A6. Youth Empowerment and Development

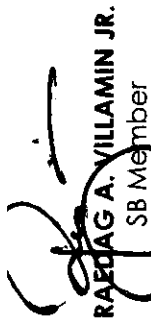
B. Conduct of regular and special sessions in accordance with the Local Government Code and other applicable laws, including the presence of quorum and proper documentation.

3.1.3. Efficiency of Performance of the Sanggunian (20%)- The ability of the Sanggunian to conduct sessions, deliberations, and hearings in a timely and transparent manner as well as adherence to established parliamentary procedures. The Sanggunian shall demonstrate compliance with parliamentary procedures, timely conduct of sessions and committee hearings, observance of publication and posting requirements under existing law.

A. Process and Procedures:

Internal Rules of Procedures contain minimum requirements such as organization of Sanggunian, creation of standing and special committees, order and calendar of business, Legislative process and parliamentary procedures:

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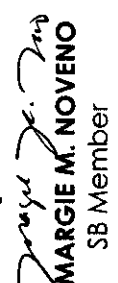

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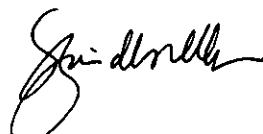

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- Notice of special sessions if any
- Submission of ordinance to Higher Sanggunian
- Posting and Publication of ordinance with penal sanction
- Notice of Committee hearings/ Meetings

3.1.4. Capacity Development for Legislators and Staff (5%)- Participation in relevant trainings, workshop, and capacity building programs that enhance legislative competence and governance practice

3.1.5. Innovation (10%) - The introduction and successful implementation of new or significantly improved ideas, processes or practices that enhance the effectiveness and efficiency of the Sanggunian ultimately benefiting their constituents. Introduction and implementation of innovative legislative measures, digital governance initiatives, environmental programs or community-based policies that significantly improve public service delivery.

SECTION 4. AWARDS CATEGORY. THERE SHALL BE TWO (2) AWARDS CATEGORY:

(A) Outstanding Sangguniang Barangays within Poblacion Area, composed of:

1. Zone 1
2. Zone 2
3. Zone 3
4. Zone 4
5. Zone 5
6. Zone 6

(B) Outstanding Sangguniang Barangays outside the Poblacion Area, composed of:

1. San Agustin
2. Amungan
3. Bangantalinga
4. Sto. Rosario
5. Lipay-Dingin-Panibuatan
6. Dirita-Baloguen
7. Sta. Barbara
8. Palanginan

SECTION 5. EVALUATION PROCEDURE:

5.1. The Municipal Awards Committee (MAC) shall evaluate all Sangguniang Barangays of the Municipality of Iba, Zambales.

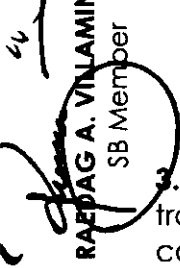
5.2. The evaluation period shall cover January to December of the preceding calendar year.

SECTION 6. AWARDS COMMITTEE: There shall be a Municipal Awards Committee (MAC) to implement the Legislative Award for Barangays. The Committee shall be composed of the following:

Chairperson: The Municipal Local Government Operation Officer (MLGOO)

V-Chairperson: The Municipal Vice Mayor

Members: The chairman of the Committee on Rules and Privileges
President, Liga ng mga Barangays
Secretary to the Sanggunian
Municipal Budget Officer
Municipal Planning and Development Office
Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO)
Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO)
Municipal Engineering office
One representative from Accredited Civil Society Organization

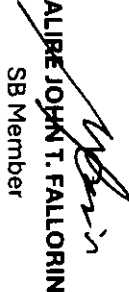

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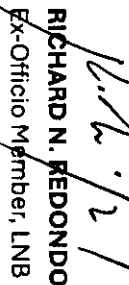

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Any member of the Municipal Awards Committee whose Barangays is under evaluation shall inhibit from the deliberation and scoring involving the said Barangays.

SECTION 7. APPROPRIATION – The Sangguniang Bayan of Iba shall appropriate a corresponding amount from its annual budget to cover the cost of implementing this award to include monetary and non-monetary prize and plaque of appreciation to all participating Barangays.

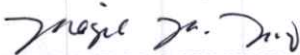
Monetary incentives, if any, shall be utilized solely for Barangays institutional or community development purposes and shall not be distributed as personal cash incentives to Barangays officials or employees.

SECTION 8. TRANSPARENCY – The results, evaluation, criteria and summary of ratings shall be made available to the public to promote transparency and accountability.

SECTION 9. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE – If any provision of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, the other provisions not otherwise affected shall remain in full force and effect.

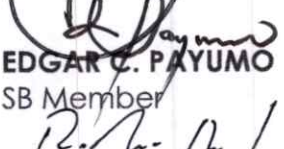
SECTION 10. EFFECTIVITY - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval and compliance with the mandated posting requirements under the Local Government Code.

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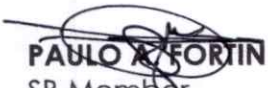

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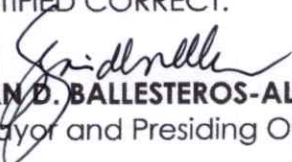
