**ORDINANCE NO. 13-09

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING A MONTHLY HONORARIUM TO ALL BARANGAY TANODS, BARANGAY NUTRITION SCHOLARS (BNS), BARANGAY HEALTH WORKERS (BHWs) AND BARANGAY POPULATION WORKERS (BPWs) IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF IBA, ZAMBALES

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that every local government unit shall exercise powers necessary to promote the general welfare of its constituents;

WHEREAS, Section 393 of the same code, provides that barangay officials and functionaries may be entitled to honoraria, allowances, and such other emoluments as may be authorized by law or barangay, municipal, or city ordinance in accordance with the budgetary limitations set forth under the Code;

WHEREAS, Barangay Tanods, Barangay Nutrition Scholars (BNS), Barangay Health Workers (BHWs), and Barangay Population Workers (BPWs) play a vital role in the

delivery of basic services and the promotion of peace and order, health, nutrition, and population programs in the barangay level;

WHEREAS, it is just and proper to recognize and provide financial assistance in the form of honorarium to Barangay Tanods and BHWs as a token of appreciation for their dedicated public service;

NOW THEREFORE be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Iba, Zambales in session assembled, that:

SECTION 1. TITLE - This Ordinance shall be known as the "Barangay Tanod, Barangay Nutrition Scholar (BNS), Barangay Health Workers (BHWs) and Barangay Population Worker (BPW) Honorarium Ordinance of the Municipality of Iba."

SECTION 2. GRANT OF HONORARIUM - All duly designated Barangay Tanods, Barangay Nutrition Scholars (BNS), Barangay Health Workers (BHWs) and Barangay Population Workers (BPW) in the Municipality of Iba shall be entitled to receive a monthly honorarium of Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00) each.

SECTION 3. SOURCE OF FUNDS - The honorarium shall be charged against the Municipal General Fund or other available lawful sources of funds, subject to existing budgeting, accounting, and auditing regulations.

SECTION 4. QUALIFICATION FOR ENTITLEMENT - To qualify for the Honorarium, Barangay Tanods, Barangay Nutrition Scholars (BNS), Barangay Health Workers (BHWs) and Barangay Population Workers (BPWs) must:

- (a) Be officially appointed or accredited by the Barangay and recognized by the Municipal Government.
- (b) Regularly perform their duties and responsibilities as certified by the Punong Barangay.
- (c) Not be absent without valid reason for more than three (3) consecutive months.

SECTION 5. ROLE OF BARANGAYS - Barangays shall submit a certified list of their official Barangay Tanods, Barangay Nutrition Scholars (BNS), accredited Barangay Health Workers (BHWs) and Barangay Population Workers (BPWs) to the Municipal Mayor's Office and Municipal Treasurer's Office for proper documentation and payroll preparation.

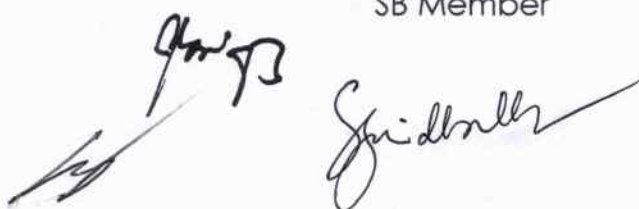
SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY - This Ordinance shall take effect after compliance with publication and posting requirements as mandated under the Local Government Code of 1991.
