**ORDINANCE NO. 13-22
SERIES OF 2026**

AN ORDINANCE RECOGNIZING AND COMMENDING BARANGAY OFFICIALS WHO HAVE RENDERED THREE (3) CONSECUTIVE FULL TERMS OF OFFICE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF IBA, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides for the structure, powers, and functions of local government units and barangay officials;

WHEREAS, barangay officials, including the Punong Barangay, Sangguniang Barangay Members, Barangay Treasurer, and Barangay Secretary, serve as frontliners in the delivery of basic services, implementation of local policies, and maintenance of peace and order within their respective communities;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Iba recognizes the dedication, commitment, and invaluable contribution of barangay officials who have faithfully served three (3) consecutive full terms of office;

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper for the Municipality to formally recognize and honor barangay officials for such long and dedicated public service through appropriate non-monetary means;

WHEREFORE, be it resolved to enact this Ordinance

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Iba, in session assembled, that:

SECTION 1. TITLE. - This Ordinance shall be known as the "**Barangay Officials Three-Term Service Recognition Ordinance of the Municipality of Iba.**"

SECTION 2. COVERAGE.

This Ordinance shall apply to the following barangay officials who have completed three (3) consecutive full terms of office immediately preceding the effectivity of this Ordinance:

1. Punong Barangay
2. Sangguniang Barangay Members (Kagawad)
3. Barangay Treasurer
4. Barangay Secretary

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS.

For purposes of this Ordinance, the following terms are defined:

- (a) **Barangay Officials** – Refers to the Punong Barangay, Sangguniang Barangay Members (Kagawad), Barangay Treasurer, and Barangay Secretary.
- (b) **Three (3) Consecutive Full Terms** – Completion of three uninterrupted terms of office as defined under Republic Act No. 7160, provided that each term is fully served.
- (c) **Qualified Awardees** – Barangay officials who have met all requirements stated under this Ordinance.
- (d) **Municipality** – Refers to the Local Government Unit of Iba.

SECTION 4. FORM OF RECOGNITION.

Qualified awardees shall be granted the following non-monetary recognition:

1. A Certificate of Recognition duly signed by the Municipal Mayor and the Presiding Officer of the Sangguniang Bayan;
2. A Plaque of Appreciation or similar commemorative token;
3. Formal recognition during an appropriate municipal program or ceremony.

No cash incentive, gratuity, honorarium, allowance, or other monetary benefit shall be granted to awardees under this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. GUIDELINES FOR IMPLEMENTATION.

1. **Verification of Eligibility.** The Municipal Office of the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) shall certify the completion of three (3) consecutive full terms of office of the grantee.
2. **Submission of Requirements.** Qualified awardees shall submit:
 - o Certificate of Service or Certification of Term Completion;
 - o Valid government-issued identification.
3. **Record-Keeping.** All supporting documents shall be filed and archived in accordance with government record-keeping rules.
4. **Monitoring.** The Municipal DILG Office shall maintain a registry of recognized officials to ensure that recognition is conferred only once.

SECTION 6. IMPLEMENTING AUTHORITY. - The Municipal Mayor, through the Municipal DILG Office and the Office of the Sangguniang Bayan, shall oversee the implementation of this Ordinance.

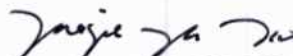
SECTION 7. LIMITATION. - Recognition under this Ordinance shall be granted only once to each qualified awardee.

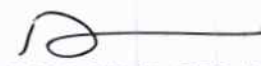
SECTION 8. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. - If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 9. REPEALING CLAUSE. - All ordinances, resolutions, executive orders, or parts thereof inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 10. EFFECTIVITY. - This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval and posting in accordance with Section 511 of Republic Act No. 7160.

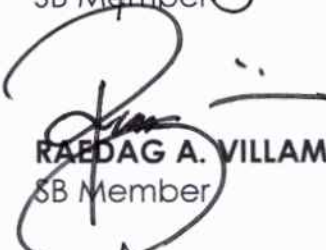

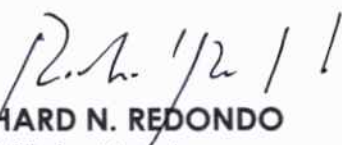

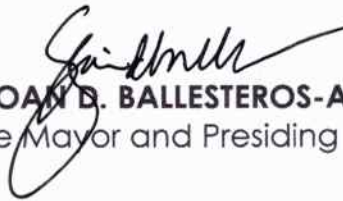
